

Rocky Mountain District Code of Conduct District Convention 2022

The following is the Code of Conduct as written in the District Policy Code:

Article XII Alcohol & Substances Policy

Section 1. The possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages or substances by members over the legal age is permitted as long as it is in accordance with state and local law.

Subsection 1.1. Members possessing and/or consuming alcoholic beverages or substances are still held to the District Code of Conduct (RMD District Policy Code, Article XV) during CKI events.

Section 2. Each club may decide on a more strict policy in regards to the possession and/or consumption of alcohol or substances during CKI events.

Section 3. Violation of this policy will result in disciplinary action at the discretion of the District Board of Officers and District Administrator.

Article XV District Code of Conduct

- There is no curfew hour. However, loud noises and disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- Individuals who wish to smoke must do so following the policies of the facility being used (i.e. hotel, convention center, camp, restaurant ect.).
- All CKI Members and guests must be respectful of others and others property.
- Care shall be taken not to deface or destroy any property. Any damages will be paid for by the individual(s) responsible.
- All CKI members and guests are expected to conduct themselves as responsible professionals and are required to attend all sessions and activities.
- Attendees will be expected to dress appropriately as prescribed in the event program.
- Every attendee will respect the authority of the district officers and administrator present.
- Infractions of the Code of Conduct will be reported to the District Board of Officers and the District Administrator. Appropriate action will be taken for any infraction, including the dismissal of any attendee from the event at the expense of the individual.
- The Code of Conduct is in effect from the moment an attendee arrives at the event until the moment he or she departs or the event officially ends.

Subsection 4.1. At any event sponsored by any other members of the Kiwanis Family, the consumption or possession of alcohol will not be tolerated during the event regardless of age or circumstance.

Section 5. Each club may decide on a more strict policy in regards to the possession or consumption of alcohol during CKI events, but their policy must coincide with the District Alcohol Policy Code.

Section 6. Violation of this policy will result in disciplinary action at the discretion of the District Board of Officers and District Administrator.

Article XIV Alcohol Policy

Section 1. The possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages by any underage member during any district events or situations sponsored or promoted by CKI will not be tolerated.

Section 2. Any member of CKI is said to be in attendance at an event from the moment of arrival at the event site until final departure.

Subsection 2.1. In any instance where pre- or post-event accommodations are included in the schedule for the event, or where an additional activity is planned and/or sponsored by CKI, or a district or club of CKI (i.e., a planned meal or district tour), such activities are bound by this policy.

Section 3. The possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages by members over the legal drinking age is permitted, however if abused the member may be asked to leave.

Subsection 3.1. Abuse may be defined as breaking the Code of Conduct for the event.

Subsection 3.2. The possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages will not be tolerated during any specified meeting times where food and drink is not involved. This includes, but is not limited to: service projects, caucusing, workshops, presentations, or general sessions.

Section 4. These guidelines will also apply to any event sponsored by Kiwanis or Golden K.

I agree to abide by the Circle K International Code of Conduct. I will respect the authority of the Circle K International District Administrator and understand infractions of the Code of Conduct will be reported by the District Administrator of Circle K International. I understand that appropriate action will be taken for any infractions, including dismissal from the convention at my expense.
